He announced that the SLO County Board of Supervisors has voted to put on the November ballot a measure to increase the sales tax by ½ per cent to fund county transportation needs. In the face of decreasing gas tax receipts and decreased state funding, this increase would raise about \$25M per year for 9 years. It would be used to help fund projects such as decreasing congestion along highway 101 in the North and South County, widen Rte 227, public transportation, and bike trails.
